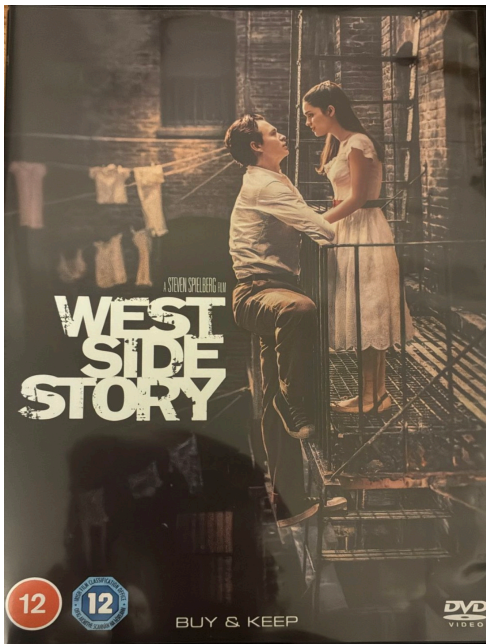
Lent Course
