## Wellbeing Walks at Bradgate Park

Walk starts at 10am prompt and lasts 90 minutes.

2 walks take place - a gentle stroll along the carriageway or a ramble into the Outer Park.



Climate change is making our weather more extreme creating more heat waves, floods and drought across the world. In the UK we are experiencing periods of less rainfall which contribute to water shortages.

Saving water also means saving energy.

**Here are some tips to reduce and reuse water:**

1. Switch to showers. If you are already a person who showers, then try to use the shower for 4 minutes or less
2. Save the water in a jug that runs before shower is up to temperature to water your plants
3. Stop using garden sprinklers. They use a vast amount of water
4. Turn off taps. Running taps waste as much as 6 litres per minute. Remember to turn off the tap when brushing your teeth and fill a bowl with water to wash fruit and vegetables
5. Make sure your dishwasher is full before turning on. Switching from a washing up bowl to a dishwasher can save up to 6000 litres a year and a further 1000 litres if dishes are not pre-rinsed
6. Use left over cooking water to water plants
7. Fix leaks promptly
8. Fix low flow aerators on your taps and showers to reduce water used without losing water pressure. Some water companies give them away for free.
9. Fill a jug of water you keep in fridge for everyday use to save running the tap as often
10. Fill up a kettle with only the amount of water you need
11. Fit an outside water butt – or two, or three. Your indoor and outdoor plants much prefer rainwater
12. Maintain appliances. Fix leaky taps and toilets. Descale your shower head regularly to maintain water pressure.
