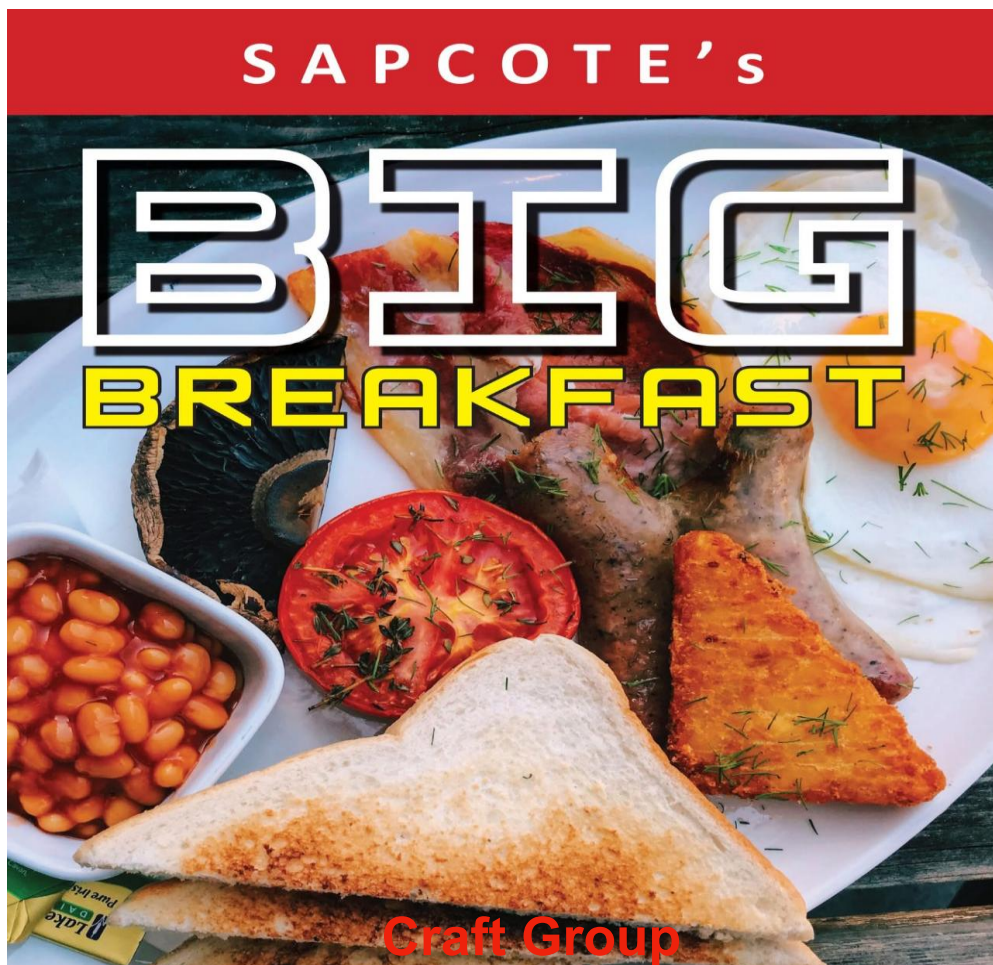

On behalf of everyone at LOROS Hospice, I would like to thank you for your recent donation of £100.00 raised from your concert held at Sapcote Methodist Church, this really is appreciated, please pass on our thanks to everyone involved. Your support will make a real difference to our patients, their families, and carers.

Last summer was one of the hardest periods we've faced. Rising costs and a growing deficit forced us to reduce our ward capacity from 31 beds to just 18, limiting care when it was needed most. Thanks to short-term NHS winter pressures funding and the incredible generosity of you and our local community, we were able to reopen four beds temporarily. I'm delighted to share that these beds will now remain open permanently, and we are also reopening two more.

However, our work isn't finished. We still can't open all 31 beds-not because the need isn't there, but because funding doesn't yet stretch far enough. With your continued support, we can reopen the remaining beds and ensure more patients and families receive the compassionate, expert care they deserve at the end of life.

From all of us at LOROS, thank you for thinking of us and for helping to secure the future of hospice care. We are very grateful.
